

PRIVACY POLICY OF AMFITRITI JEWELS

1. DATA CONTROLLER

The data controller of personal data processed within the Website is Paulina Biłda, conducting business activity at the registered address at 24 Leśna street, 16-400 Suwałki, Poland.

2. PERSONAL DATA

2.1 Providing your Personal Data is voluntary, which Client does directly to the Data Controller through filling up the forms available on the Website.

2.2 Non-provision of some necessary Personal Data might result in impossibility to place an order or using some of the Website's functions or services. The Client commits that provided Personal Data are true. Due to the type of service provided electronically, it is not possible to use it anonymously.

2.3 If the Client provides us with Personal Data of third parties, he/she will be responsible for informing such third parties and obtaining their consent to provide such data for the purposes indicated in the relevant chapters of this Privacy Policy.

3. SCOPE OF COLLECTED PERSONAL DATA

3.1 Data, such as your name, company (if applicable), e-mail address, delivery address, we collect in the result of a distance sales contract between the Data Controller and the Client. Data Controller processes the data given in the purchase process and using the website functions.

We will process the Client's data for the time needed to manage the purchase of products or services, including possible returns, complaints or complaints related to a specific product or service and until the statute of limitations resulting from the above claims.

3.2. Data collected as a result of contact by e-mail, when the Client whose data relates is directed to Data Controller's query or other type of correspondence. The Data Controller can process this data that were provided, such as name, email address, mailing address. We will process the client's data for the time it takes to process their request.

4. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

4.1 The purpose of processing Personal Data is to conclude a distance purchase contract for products. The data collected during the purchase transaction will be used to complete the transaction and delivery of products to the Client.

4.2. Client data provided to the Data Controller are also processed to contact with the Client via email, telephone, or other equivalent forms electronic communication, if necessary.

4.3. Additional personal data, such as an e-mail address, are collected only in places where the Client, by completing the form, expressly consented. We save and use the above data only to the needs necessary to perform a given function.

5. VOLUNTARY PROVISION OF PERSONAL DATA

5.1 Providing personal data is voluntary, but failure to do so may be result in impossibility to provide some services available on the Website.

6. SHARING PERSONAL DATA

6.1 To achieve the goals set out in this Privacy Policy, your Personal Data must be made available to third parties that support the Data Controller in providing services offered, that is to say:

- financial institutions,
- institutions involved in the detection and prevention of fraud,
- technology service providers,
- suppliers and partners in the provision of logistics, transport and delivery services.

7. THE RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

7.1 We undertake to respect the confidentiality of the Client's Personal Data and to guarantee the opportunity to exercise their rights. Each Client has the right to access data, rectify, delete or limit processing, the right to object, the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory body: <https://www.uodo.gov.pl>. The Client may also withdraw the given consent to the processing of their Personal Data, by writing to the above e-mail address.

7.2 The right to delete the Personal Data does not apply if the Client has an open order which has not been sent yet or has been sent only partially, or has unfinished proceedings regarding complaints or has an unpaid debt to the Data Controller.

7.3 If the Client has given us permission to process their Data for any purpose, such a consent might be withdrawn at any time.

8. DATA PROTECTION

8.1. The Data Controller ensures the security of Personal Data through appropriate means - technical and organizational measures to prevent unlawful Data processing and their accidental loss, destruction and damage.
